

## **Middle School Upgrades Since 1955**

1. In 1955 there was a major upgrade of the existing 1926 structure along with the addition of the newer section of the building in the north/east corner.  
**Unknown Costs**
2. In 1983 the fire alarm system was upgraded to include more modern equipment and the addition of fire doors in all major hallways. **Unknown Cost**
3. In 1988 an elevator was added to the north/east corner of the building to meet the ADA requirements for accessibility. \$250,000.
4. In 1990 the library was completely renovated to include new carpet, ceiling, and all new furniture. \$50,000.
5. In 1990 the entire roof system was replaced with a new rubber membrane system with improved insulation. \$150,000.
6. In 1990 all major asbestos issues were dealt with during a major abatement project that included removal and re-insulation of the boilers and most of the associated distribution piping. \$92,163.
7. In 1993 all of the existing lighting in the building was upgraded to new technology, including all fluorescent lighting with electronic ballasts, and or compact fluorescents. \$35,000.
8. In 1994 a wheel chair lift was installed to allow access to the cafeteria by handicapped individuals. \$14,000.
9. In 2000 the entire old hallway floor tile was removed and new tile was installed on all floors \$30,000.
10. In 2000 a new communications system was installed allowing inter office and inter classroom communications. \$5600.
11. In 2001 the existing 10,000-gallon oil tank was replaced with a newer 10,000-gallon tank complete with spill detection and in tank monitoring of oil levels, temperature, etc.\$27,000.
12. In 2002 through 2004 the auditorium was renovated including new paint, carpet renovated seating, and new stage curtains. Left to do are stage floor sanding and refinishing and new stage lighting system. \$70,892.
13. In 2002 thru 2004 all the old classroom doors have been replaced with new fire rated doors complete with closures, door locks and magnetic door holders. \$75,000.
14. And since 1983 the fire alarm system has been continually upgraded with newer smoke detectors and alarms and pull stations, several areas in the building that were never protected now are. \$4,000.
